### **NORMALIZE**

Start the conversation by communicating that emotional difficulties are common and expected, minimize the likelihood of the "I'm fine" response.



#### ASK

Ask open-ended, non-checklist questions, and keep your questions brief so the patient or family can do most of the talking. Match your nonverbals to your words as well.



#### PAUSE

Pause to let them know you want to hear what they have to say. This also gives them time to gather their thoughts as it may have been their first time being asked.



## CONNECT

Inquire about existing supports and encourage individuals to use them.

This is also an opportunity to connect them with professionals or additional resources.
